



Historic Preservation Fund Grants

The State Historic Preservation Office of North Dakota receives federal funds annually from the Historic Preservation Fund to assist in the identification, evaluation, and preservation of cultural resources listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

Deadline: October 31, 2023

Cultural Heritage Grants (CHG)

The Cultural Heritage Grant Program provides grant funding for non-profits, museums and historical societies for exhibits, special projects, events, education activities, collections projects, and capital improvements.

Deadline: September 15, 2023

Archival Supply Purchase Grants

Archival Supply Purchase Grants provide grants for local and county historical societies, museums, and archives to purchase archival supplies.

Deadline: Grants will be awarded throughout the biennium until the fund is exhausted.

Heritage Training Scholarships

Heritage Training Scholarships are available for local and county historical society staff members to participate in training opportunities.

Deadline: Grants will be awarded throughout the biennium until the fund is exhausted.

Main Street Community Education Grants

Main Street Community Education Grants focus on partnerships between the teacher/educator and a local museum or history organization. Teachers and educators of all levels are encouraged to apply.

Deadline: Grants will be awarded throughout the biennium until the fund is exhausted.

North Dakota Museum Assessment Program (NDMAP)

North Dakota Museum Assessment Program provides a grant to city, county, or regional historical societies, museums, and history organizations to perform an in-depth review of their organization and develop a long-range plan.

Deadline: September 30, 2023
